<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Completion of an associate degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.00 or higher. Submit official college transcripts from ALL colleges attended (except for Clark College) and send updated official college transcripts each term (if applicable). <i>The BAS-degree cannot be awarded unless all program requirements are satisfied, and 180 college-level credits are posted to the Clark College transcript.</i> Complete the following courses with a grade of "C" (2.0) or higher: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> English Composition I (ENGL& 101). May already be a part of your prior degree. Communication Skills (CMST& 210 or 220 or 230) College level Math (Math 100 level or higher). May already be a part of your prior degree.
