Attempt and <b>submit official scores</b> for the Washington Educator Skills Test – Basic (WEST-B) or an equivalent assessment in the areas of reading, writing, and mathematics. <b>Important Note:</b> Students may apply to the program with proof of registration for the test (screen capture is okay), then submit official results as soon as they become available.
