Remote Tutoring Tips:

#1 Log in and get familiar with the site *before* it is needed. This will reduce stress and help the first session go more smoothly.

#2 Allow plenty of time to receive a response when using the Online Writing Lab and eQuestions. A tutor typically responds within 24-48 hours, but it may take longer during peak usage.

#3 Provide the tutor with as much information as possible about the assignment, the questions they may have, and upload any assignment prompts.

#4 Be patient and allow time to adjust to online tutoring. It feels different from face-to-face tutoring but can be just as helpful!
