- Watercolor Pan Set—MeiLiang watercolor set @\$20 (or your own)
  \*If your watercolor comes in paper packing unwrap and put in palette, so it's ready for class.

- 3. Paper—Strathmore 300 Series 140 lb paper 24 sheet \$14.21
