Course Description: Have you always wanted to try out this beautiful art form? Learn the fundamentals and be guided with step-by-step instructions. You will learn a new technique each week and have fun painting with watercolors.

Outcome #2: Identify watercolor tubes and pan watercolors

Outcome #3: Create a color wheel to understand color wheel

1. Watercolor Pan Set—Meiliang watercolor set @\$20 (or your own)
*If your watercolor comes in paper packing unwrap and put in palette, so it's ready for class.
2. Brushes—Artstories paint brushes \$7.99 (or your own)
3. Paper—Strathmore 300 Series 140 lb paper 24 sheet \$14.21
