Dear Clark College Student,

We would like to invite you to apply for the DREAMER Scholarship. The scholarship is designed to help current and future Clark College students that identify as DREAMER. *DREAMers is an affirmative term for undocumented students in the US. DREAMers exist in every state and come from all parts of the world including North and Central America, Asia, South America, Africa, Europe, and other regions of the world. In Washington State, students can also be recognized as HB1079 students.* The DREAMER Scholarship will be awarded from the NW Community Founds.

Scholarship awards will vary in size and will not exceed the cost of twelve credits at Clark College. Awards may be used in either fall or winter quarter.

To be considered for the DREAMER Scholarship, an applicant must be:

- Currently enrolled at Clark College for at least six credits per term
- A student of color who identify as a DREAMER student:

Asian: A person with origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or Indian Subcontinent.

African American/Black: A person with origins in any of the Black racial groups of Africa

<u>Pacific Islander</u>: A person with origins in any of the original peoples the Pacific Islands.

<u>Latino:</u> A person of Mexican, South American or other Spanish culture or origin regardless of race
