11th/12th Grade English Elective	Must pass ENGL&101 English Composition I & ENGL&102 English Composition II before anything else
Math Elective	College Level Math (100 level)
Science Elective	Any 'Natural Science' such as: Chemistry, Biology, Astronomy, Physics, Geology, etc.
US History: 1.0 High School credit; Choose one of the options	HIST&146 US History I HIST&147 US History II HIST&148 US History III HIST&215 Women in US History
Civics/Social Studies Elective: 1.0 High School credit; Choose one of the options	POLS&111 American National Gov & Politics (Clark) POLS&202 American Government (LCC)
CWP: 1.0 High School credit; Choose one of the options	POLS&203 International Relations ECON&110 Intro to Global Economy ECON&202 Macroeconomics GEOG&207 Economic Geography
WA State History	HIST&214 Pacific Northwest History
PE: 1.50 credits	Any PE/Fitness Class including HPE courses 1 RS unit = .20 LCHS credit
Health: .50 credit	Includes HLTH 100 level and HPE courses 3 RS units = .60 LCHS credit
Fine/Performing Arts	Any fine/visual/performing arts class such as music, pottery, photography
Elective	Any class can count towards elective credit

- Make sure to refer to La Center High School's specific graduation requirements to determine what courses you need from Clark.
- In order to walk at the LCHS graduation ceremony, you must complete ALL LCHS graduation requirements by the end of winter quarter your senior year.**
- La Center High School requires all students to complete 24 credits for a diploma.
- 1 unit at Clark College or LCC = .20 credit at LCHS.
- All students, class of 2020 and beyond, must complete a Xello profile and present a senior student led conference (SLC) to meet their high school and beyond graduation requirement.
- Women's Studies at Clark or LCC counts as elective credit with LCHS.
