Cost	Amount
Student ID Cards	\$9.00 Annual ID, valid September 1 through August 31 each year (optional)
Associated Student Fees	\$7.25* per credit, per term
Additional Fees (each course may have additional fees)	Estimated \$30 - \$150* (online fees \$5 and \$25 per class). In addition, each course may have a class fee, course fee and other fees associated
First Day Digital Access (FDDA online book fees)	Estimated at \$20 - \$100* per FDDA charge (dependent on course)
Books (sold at bookstore)	Estimated at \$75-150* per book (dependent on course).
Transportation	C-Tran Bus Pass: Free with purchase of Student ID card*. Replacement: \$48, if lost or stolen*
