



RUNNING START COST BREAKDOWN

Cost	Amount
Student ID Cards	\$9.00* Annual ID, valid September 1 through August 31 each year (optional).
Associated Student Fees	\$7.25* per credit, per term – This charge covers matriculation, technology and facilities fees.
Course Fees	\$30 – \$45* per course – Course fees will depend on the number of credits taken and the course types. Some courses may have slightly higher course fees.
Books	Estimated at \$50 - \$150* per book, per term.
Transportation	C-Tran Bus Pass: \$15* per quarter. Replacement: \$48*, if lost or stolen Gas for driving (no parking permits required on campus).
