The Associate in Arts (AA) degree is designed for students planning to transfer to a four-year institution to pursue a bachelor's degree program. The degree, in most cases, meets the first two (2) years of general education requirements at the senior institution. There are exceptions; please check with the transfer institution for additional information. Most students transferring with the AA/DTA degree will be granted junior standing upon entry to the senior institution (more info at <a href="www.clark.edu/advising/transfer">www.clark.edu/advising/transfer</a>). The standard Associate in Arts degree is also known as a Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA) Associate degree.
