

Clark College Second Year Loan Certification

- You are a second year student if you have successfully completed 50% of the required credits in your current program of study.
- If you have been accepted into the Nursing, Dental Hygiene, or the Medical Radiography program, you are considered second year, after successfully completing 50% of the major area program requirements (see Clark College Catalog).
- Your loan amount may be prorated based on the number of credits remaining in your current program of study.
- If you need to complete pre-college (under 100 level) classes that are not required in the major area program requirements (see Clark College Catalog), you are considered a first year student.

3. The academic advisor will return the completed form to the Financial Aid Office.
