**Work Study** is a form of financial aid earned through part-time employment on or off campus. To qualify, students must be enrolled in at least six credits. Eligibility is based on demonstrated financial need and is awarded for fall, winter, and spring terms. Summer Work Study may be available upon request.

**Federal Direct Loans** are a form of financial aid that must be repaid in full, with interest, after the borrower graduates or drops below half-time (6 credits). There are two types of Federal Direct Loans:

**Federal Direct Subsidized Loan:** Awarded to undergraduate students, based on demonstrated financial need. Interest is paid by the Department of Education while the borrower is enrolled in at least six credits at a qualifying school.

**Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan:** Awarded to undergraduate and graduate students, not based on financial need. The borrower is responsible for interest accrued while in school.

**Additional Loan Information**

- To be eligible to receive a loan, you must:
  - Complete the FAFSA for the current academic year
  - Enroll in at least 6 eligible credits each term
  - Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (min. 2.00 GPA and 67% pace of progression)
- Loan amounts are limited by annual borrowing limits, and eligibility is reduced for less than full-time enrollment
- Subsidized loans will be awarded before unsubsidized loans
- First-time borrowers must complete [Entrance Counseling](#) and [Master Promissory Note \(MPN\)](#)
- Loan origination fee is 1.057% (deducted before disbursement)
- Loans may be cancelled within 14 days of disbursement
