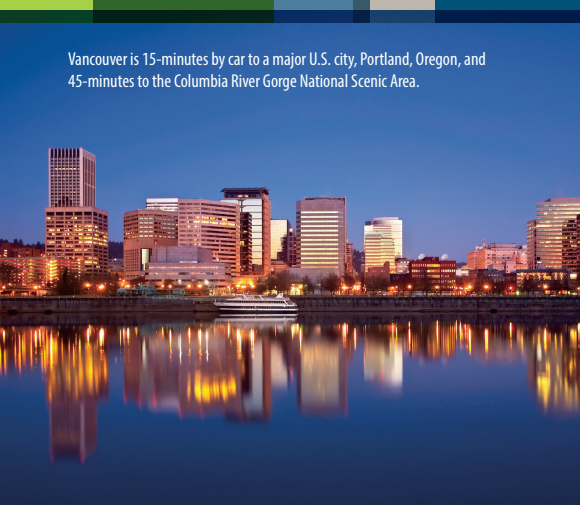
## IELP LEVELS:

<b>LEVEL 1– ESSENTIAL</b>	Students will study basic reading, writing, listening and speaking. Learning technology will be introduced.
<b>LEVEL 2 – INTERMEDIATE</b>	Students will study intermediate reading, writing, listening and discussion skills. Students will also learn about U.S. colleges and learning technology.
<b>LEVEL 3– ADVANCED</b>	Students will study advanced reading, writing, academic vocabulary, listening, conversation, group work and basic presentation skills. Use of learning technology and exploration of college majors will be included.
<b>LEVEL 4– UPPER ADVANCED</b>	Students will study U.S. college preparation skills including reading and writing academic essays, note taking and study skills. Expanded use of learning technology and public speaking, including class discussions and presentations, will be emphasized.
<b>Students may be advised to register for Math with IELP classes if needed.</b>
