Watch Out for Browser Warnings

Get a warning banner about the website you are trying to visit? Avoid the site and go to a different one to get the information you need.



Check for Encryption

Find the padlock or HTTPS next to the website address to know information is protected in transit.



Get Authorized

Before installing any software, plugins, add-ons, or extensions, check our policies and procedures to ensure it is authorized or ask the help desk for help.



Once Installed, Keep It Updated

Make sure that your browsers and plugins always have the latest patches and updates.
