

Clark women take opener of crossover

Penguins defeat Blue Mountain

The Clark College women's basketball team won its opening game of its crossover tournament Friday, downing Blue Mountain 75-65 at the O'Connell Center.

Skyview High grad Macy Mukensnabl led the Penguins with 18 points and 12 re-

bounds.

Deborah Simmers scored 16 points, and Chelsea Dyson had 14 points and nine assists as Clark improved to 4-3 on the season.

Blue Mountain of Pendleton, Ore., was led by Stephanie Lopez' 33 points.

The Penguins face Mt. Hood at 6 p.m. Saturday in the semifinal round. Mt. Hood was a 68-62 winner over Everett.
