

Clark honors go to Lane, Mueller

Two All-America athletes have been named the Clark College Student Athletes of the Month for May, the school announced Tuesday.

Mueller, a Clark freshman and Mountain View High School graduate, is an All-American in the 10-kilometer run, and placed second in that event at the

Northwest Athletic Association of Community Colleges (NWAACC) championships with a time of 40 minutes, 10 seconds. The next day, she placed fifth in the 5,000 meters in 19:12. Track and field head coach Amber Moore said, "Kat is a hard working, dedicated athlete who has shown great improvement from high school."

A member of the Clark's NWAACC championship women's cross country team, Mueller is expected to compete in both cross country and track next year.

Lane, a Clark sophomore and Skyview High School graduate, is the two-time high jump NWAACC champion and an All-American in the event. He cleared better than 6-foot-7 in both 2010 and 2011.

"Tyler's hard work and dedication to the track and field team helped the Penguins by scoring points throughout the season in the high jump, long jump, decathlon, 4x100 and javelin," Moore said.

The coach said Lane "will return to Clark next season to help coach the jumps while taking his redshirt year before he transfers to continue his education."

Lane previously earned Student Athlete of the Month honors in April 2010.
