

Clark College to present Rabbit Hole, final production of season

Clark College will present the final production in the 2011-2012 season, *Rabbit Hole*, with performances May 4, 5, 11, 12, 18 and 19, at Decker Theatre in the Frost Arts Center, 1933 Fort Vancouver Way, Vancouver.

Written by David Lindsay-Abaire and directed by Patricia Rohrbach, the Pulitzer-Prize winning *Rabbit Hole* is a study of a couple mourning the death of their child. *Rabbit Hole* is

Evening performances will be May 4, 5, 11, 12, 18 and 19, 7:30 p.m. and a matinee performance will be May 12, 2 p.m.
