Clark College to hold State of the College Address Jan. 19

Along with several other pressing key issues, Clark College President Robert Knight will address what it means when a college that has been state supported is now only state assisted during his 2012 State of the College Address Thurs., Jan. 19, 11 a.m.-noon, at the Gaiser Student Center, 1933 Fort Vancouver Way, Vancouver.
