

# Clark College to host group show of artists

Clark College's Archer Gallery will be the site of a group show of artists exploring real and perceived space in paint.

"Considered Space" is the theme of the show, to be offered Feb. 17-March 14 at the gallery, located in the Penguin Union Building, 1933 Fort Vancouver Way, Vancouver. During the show, the gallery will be open Tues.-Thurs., 10 a.m.-7 p.m., Friday, 10 a.m.-4 p.m. and Saturday 1-5 p.m.

A special reception is planned for Wed., Feb. 18, 4-6 p.m. There is no admission fee.

The show will explore the presentation of space in painting. Several of the artists al-

lude to physical space through traditional tools of perspective, scale and color and others are integrating real space into painting through dimensional materials and constructions.

The mediums range from oil on linen or canvas to paint on constructed wood and paint on fiber.

Drawing from regional artists, the exhibition will feature work by Jesse Hayward, Mark R. Smith, Grant Hottle, Adam Sorensen, Cara Tomlinson, Ben Buswell and Lise Graham.
