Children without dental insurance can sign up for free dentist appointments at Clark College next month.

X-rays, sealants, fluoride treatment, fillings, extractions and advice will be offered for those who sign up; cleanings won't.

The event runs from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Clark College Dental Hygiene Clinic, 1933 Fort Vancouver Way.
