The Clark College club baseball team dropped two close games to the George Fox junior varsity on Saturday. Clark (6-15) lost 5-4 and 5-3.

Zach Girod was 3 for 3 with two doubles and two RBI in the opener for the Penguins.

Clark rallied from 4-0 down to tie the game with three runs in the fifth and one in the sixth. George Fox pushed across the winning run in the top of the ninth.

George Fox broke a 3-3 tie in the second game with a two-run sixth. Girod continued with the hot bat, going 3 for 3 with a solo home run and a double.
