

Clark men travel for tiebreaker game

The Clark College men's basketball team will play today at Grays Harbor in Aberdeen in a Northwest Athletic Association of Community Colleges playoff game. Tipoff is scheduled for 8 p.m.

Tonight's winner will be the fourth-place team from the West Division in the NWAACC Tournament, which runs Thursday through Sunday at the Toyota Center in Kennewick.

Clark initially expected to

be hosting a playoff game today. But South Puget Sound beat division champion Lower Columbia on Saturday to claim third place outright in the West. That left Clark and Grays Harbor tied for fourth place at 8-8.

A random NWAACC formula determined Grays Harbor will host today's contest.

The teams split their two league games, both winning at home. Grays Harbor beat Clark, 92-78, on Jan. 9. The Penguins beat the Chokers, 77-75, on Feb. 6.
