Clark College restocks foundation, other panels

Ten local professionals with extensive business and education experience have been appointed to the boards of the Clark College Foundation, Alumni Association and Penguin Athletic Club, the college announced Friday.

Larry Easter, Jason Joner and Rick Takach will each serve a three-year term on the Foundation board of directors.

Easter is a professor emeritus at Clark College, where he taught psychology and computer science. Joner, an attorney with Miller Nash, has taught business and corporate law in the Clark College paralegal program. Takach is president and CEO of Vesta Hospitality, a

national hotel management and development firm.

Established in 1973, the foundation is a nonprofit, tax-exempt group that serves as the fundraising arm of Clark College.
