Clark's Henderson a double winner at NWAACC meet

Clark College freshman Brittany Henderson was a double winner at the NWAACC track and field championships, held Thursday and Friday at Spokane.

The Prairie High grad won the 800-meter run in 2 minutes, 18.31 seconds, and also

won the 1,500 in 4:54.02.

Sophomore Nick Smith won the 800 for the Clark men with a time of 1:55.43.

Ryan Barrett came in second in the 400 (47.99) and third in the 200 (22.03).

Heritage grad Shane Weldon placed third in 10,000 (33:33.3) and fourth in the 5,000 (15:47.01).

The Clark men placed sixth as a team.

Spokane swept the team titles. The Sasquatch men scored a meet-record 277.5 points to beat out Lane. The women scored 224, also beating out second-place Lane.
