Clark College basketball players Ryan Anderson and Leanne Lamping have been selected as the schools Athletes of the Month for January.

Anderson is a 6-foot-4 starting wing, averaging 7.1 points and 1.0 rebounds a game. A graduate of Camas High School, Anderson has a 3.56 grade point average.
