

Clark College president to speak at banquet

Clark College president Bob Knight is scheduled to be the keynote speaker for the National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame Clark County Chapter Scholar-Athlete Awards Banquet. The event will be held at 7 p.m. on Jan. 16 at Hudson's Bay High School.

The dinner honors two high school senior football players from each Southwest Washington high school for their success with academics, community service, and athletics. Six of them will be awarded scholarships to assist with their college education. Three scholarships will be awarded to backs and three to linemen.

Now in its 16th year, the Clark County chapter of the NFF has awarded approximately \$225,000 in scholarship money.

"You'll see no better role models than you'll see that night," said Gery Gehrmann, president of the Clark County chapter of the NFF.
