

Gregoire chooses local leaders

Washington Gov. Chris Gregoire chose three Clark County residents for state service.

Michael Ciraulo was appointed to the state's Fire Protection Policy Board, representing Washington cities and towns in the three-year term. He is mayor of the city of Battle Ground and division chief for Clark County Fire and Rescue. He has worked in fire service for 22 years and served on Battle Ground's city council for six years.

Leann Johnson was reappointed to the state Arts Commission for three years. She is director for equity and diversity at Clark College and was a member of the Governor's Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee. Johnson also served on the board of directors for the YWCA of Clark County and is a member of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.
