Clark College changes work force programs

Clark College has renamed its work force development unit to "Workforce Education" as part of broader efforts to streamline job training at the college. The changes began in mid-2007, when the unit became part of the college's office of instruction.

In addition, the college is restructuring three positions in its office of instruction and its former work force development unit. The new positions are: dean of instructional planning and operations, held on an interim basis by Sylvia Thornburg; director of instructional programming and innovation, held by George Reese; and director of work force education and economic development, held on an interim basis by Joe Renouard.
